

Paper Fortune Teller for Asking Good Questions

This activity is designed to help children practice asking diverse questions. You can have two children work together or you can work together with one child.

How to fold your fotune tellers:

The best way is to go to YouTube and search for "How to fold paper fortune tellers." The tutorials are really clear.

Suggested play format:

- 1. Child 1 says, "Spell your name." For each letter, the child holding the Fortune Teller manipulates the device back and forth.
- 2. Child 2 is then shown the two options appearing on the inner triangles and makes a selection.
- 3. Child 1 opens up the innermost petals, where four options appear.

He selects A, and then directs child 2 to ask the question that is shown.
